Appendix II

Description:

This course will present a foundation for understanding, assessing and treating core postural problems in children with sensory integration and processing problems. Emphasis will be on identifying and treating foundational functional postural control difficulties that impact respiration, praxis and skill performance. Intervention strategies for effective treatment of postural mobility, stability, static and dynamic control and movement against gravity will be presented. Discussion of the structural and sensory foundations of postural control will be presented. The course format will include a combination of lecture, videotapes, and hands-on lab activities.

Learning Objectives: By the end of this talk the participant will be able to:

- 1. Describe the structural and sensory foundations of postural control.
- 2. Assess and identify areas of deficit in a variety of aspects of postural control.
- 3. Demonstrate at least 5 intervention techniques or activities to promote various aspects of postural control within the context of sensory integration intervention.

Level:

This course is an introductory course and would be appropriate for entry to intermediate level OT, PT, OT aides/assts, PT aides/assts. A previous knowledge of sensory integration theory would be recommended. Course Credit/ Continuing Education Units: This course qualifies for 6 clock hours as required by many national, state and local licensing boards and professional organizations.
