The Department provides extensive occupational therapy service in psychiatry. Before taking up her current position, she was supervising the child psychiatric occupational service provision at Kwai Chung Hospital, Yaumatei and Kwai Chung Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Centre for more than 25 years. She worked with children and adolescents with special needs such as ADHD, SLD, and Autism. She gives talks, seminars and workshops to parents, teachers and the professionals working with children in conferences, symposiums, and training workshops in Hong Kong and China. She has been the author or co-author of published books, assessment tools and journal papers.
